Hear an update from the people leading the Wynyard Edge Alliance delivery of infrastructure for the 36th America's Cup. The Wynyard Edge Alliance was established by the Crown and Auckland Council in partnership with mana whenua and Emirates team New Zealand to enable Tāmaki Makaurau, Auckland and New Zealand to host the 36th America's Cup in 2021. The focus is to ensure the essential infrastructure is provided on time and that the America's Cup event takes place safely while show casing Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland and New Zealand to the world. The Alliance has currently completed 7 of 13 milestones on time, including 5 'stages' (building platforms) made available for syndicates to build their bases. Progress continues safely and at pace with a further 6 milestones on track to be passed this year. The Wynyard Edge Alliance comprises Auckland council, the Crown, McConnell Dowell, Downer, Tonkin & Taylor and Beca.
