Background:

Auckland's Procurement Programme is a part of MBIE's Productivity Partnership. The Productivity Partnership is a linking of industry and government which is driving key initiatives to address the issue of low productivity in New Zealand's building and construction industry. The Auckland Procurement Forum is the heart of the Programme, with a three to five year plan to drive for more efficient procurement and project delivery working practises. There are four workstreams, one of which is "Driving waste from Procurement".

The Procurement Workstream Working group is tasked with identifying a set of industry-wide game-changing initiatives and quick wins. It is chaired by Sarah Sinclair Auckland Council's Chief Engineer and Graham Wood, Watercare's CIO acts as Sponsor. The Working Group comprises Auckland Transport, Vector, NZTA, Transpower, Fulton Hogan, HEB, JFC, MWH, GHD, RCP.

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
