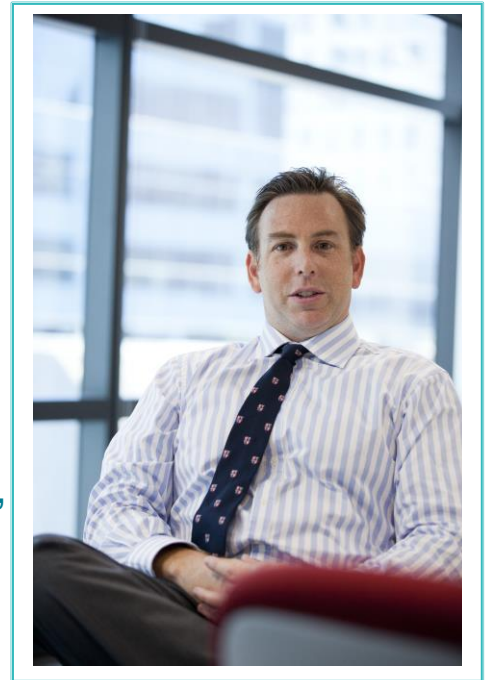
Institution of Civil Engineers Australasia Speaker Tour
