Wellington Water Alliance

Wellington Water is a Council Controlled Organisation that manages the three waters assets on behalf of its six share-holding Councils – Wellington City, Hutt City, Upper Hutt City, and Porirua City Councils, South Wairarapa District Council, and the Greater Wellington Regional Council.

The Alliance is a partnership between Fulton Hogan and Wellington Water that is responsible for the maintenance and operation of the three waters assets that Wellington Water manages. This includes the three waters network, maintenance of the Water Treatment Plants, but excludes operation of the Water Treatment Plants, Waste Water Treatment Plants, and capital improvement programmes.

The Alliance commenced on 1 July 2019, comprises 150 staff, leverages a further 100+ subcontractors to delivers its services, looks after 6000 km of pipes, services a population of over 465,000 people, supplies over 140-170 million litres of drinking water to homes and business every day, and similarly takes away 150 million litres of wastewater per day.

Gary O'Meara is a senior engineer with over 40 years of experience in the water sector. He has held a broad mix of roles in local government including Water Supply Manager at Hutt City Council and COO at Capacity Infrastructure Services Ltd. Gary's current role is Network Controller – Principal Advisor at Wellington Water. Prior to this role Gary was Group Manager - Network and Customer Operations at Wellington Water in which he was responsible for leading the formation of the integrated Alliance with Fulton Hogan to deliver the maintenance and operations of the three water assets across the Wellington region.

Kevin Locke is a professional engineer with over 25 years of experience in the infrastructure sector. He has held a broad mix of roles in the private sector and in local and central government. He has worked as a client, consultant and contractor and has a blend of both executive and governance experience.

Kevin's current role is Group Manager, Customer Operations at Wellington Water. The Customer Operations Group is an Alliance between Wellington Water and Fulton Hogan – an innovative partnership that is fully integrated into Wellington Water. Prior to this role, Kevin was Fulton Hogan's General Manager of Strategy and Growth for their New Zealand business. Before joining Fulton Hogan, Kevin was General Manager Capital Programme Group at Christchurch City Council where he was responsible for the rebuild of Council's damaged infrastructure and facilities, including leading the establishment of the SCIRT rebuild alliance.
