Each contract was allocated a Performance Benchmark Handbook outlining the applicable KPI's and how they are measured



Each supplier and Auckland City contract manager has access to an on-line web based reporting tool and was provided with training in its use



KPI's becoming an agenda item for monthly contract management meetings



The establishment of a benchmarking club with 4 meetings held per year, attended by the suppliers, and Auckland City contract managers
