Standardise contract prequalifications:

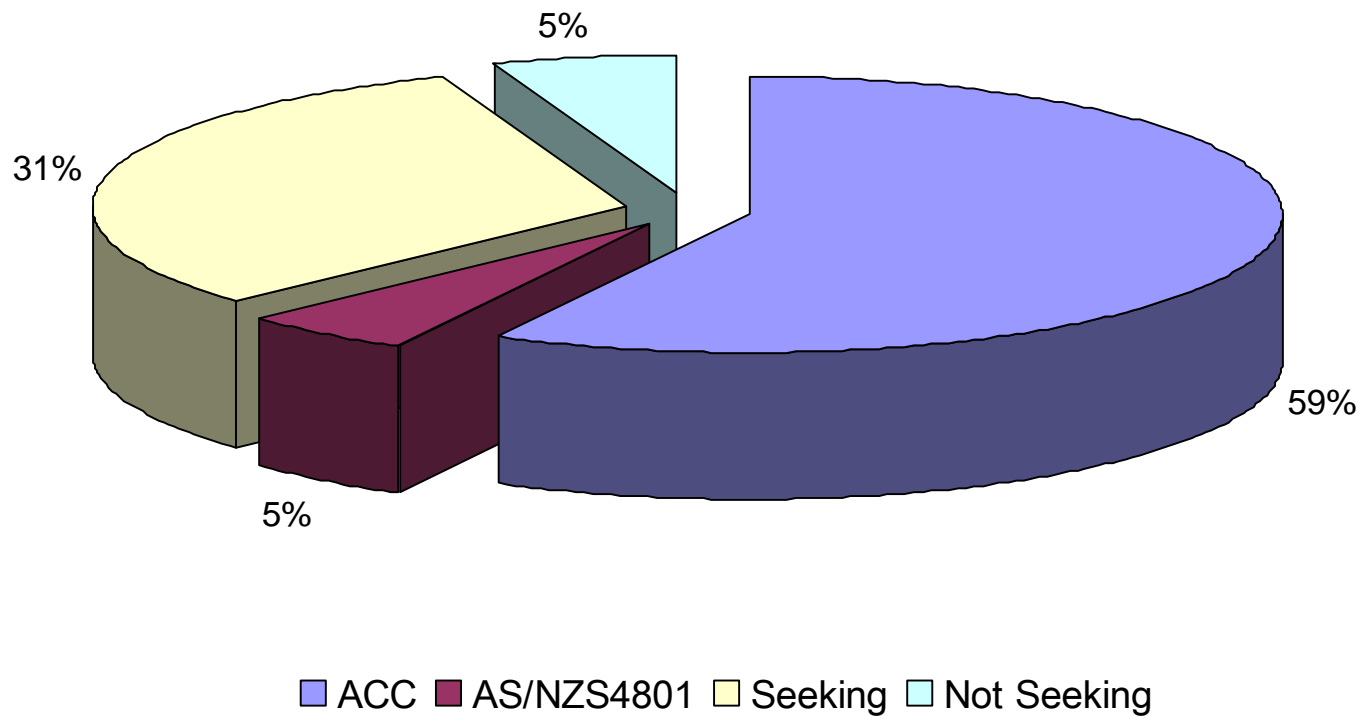
- National accreditation
