Brief Description of Module Content	Students will gain an understanding of how to develop performance measures (KPIs) for projects and businesses. They will learn how to implement them across the organisation. In addition, the course will look at how to specifically benchmark construction projects using the CCG NZ International KPIs, and how to implement them as an ongoing business tool. Students will be shown how to design a performance improvement system using concepts such as Kaizen, as a basis for a step by step approach to setting stretch targets and achieving them.
