




- •14.5% reduction in injury rates between 2002 and 2005







- •39,000 largely untrained, unskilled workers entered construction between 2000 and 2005


Agriculture reduced by 12.7%



Matrix of Injury Prevention




Matrix of Workplace Injury Prevention Intervention








