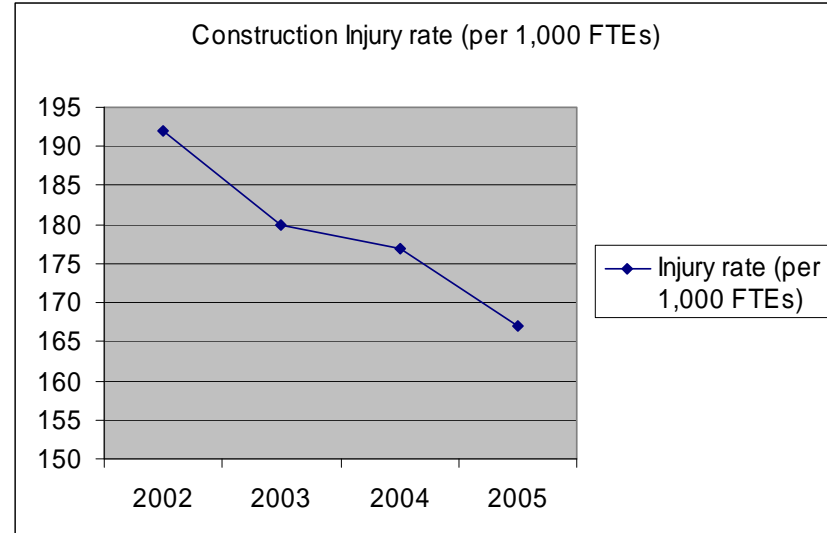

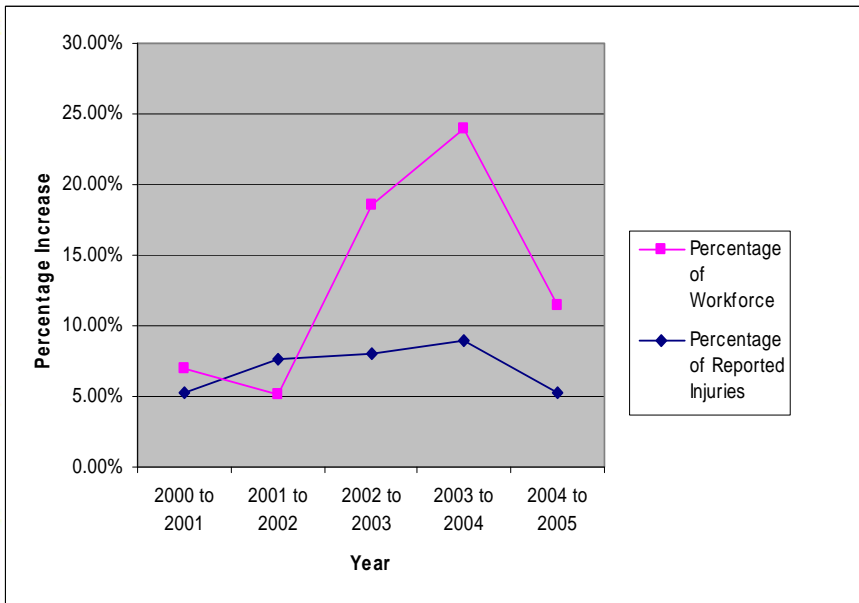
# Current Statistics



- Data from Statistics NZ
- 14.5% reduction in injury rates between 2002 and 2005



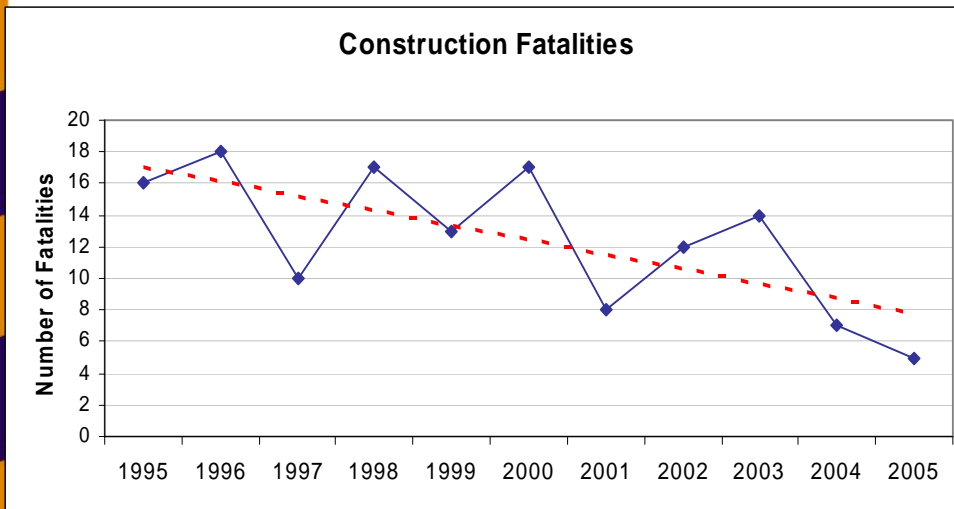
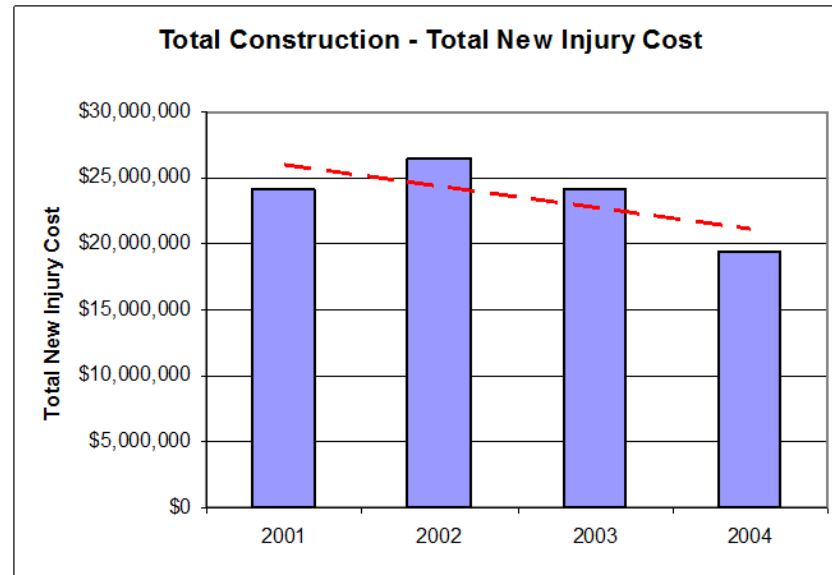
- 39,000 largely untrained, unskilled workers entered construction between 2000 and 2005
- Injuries would be expected to rise during this period

# ACC Safer Industries



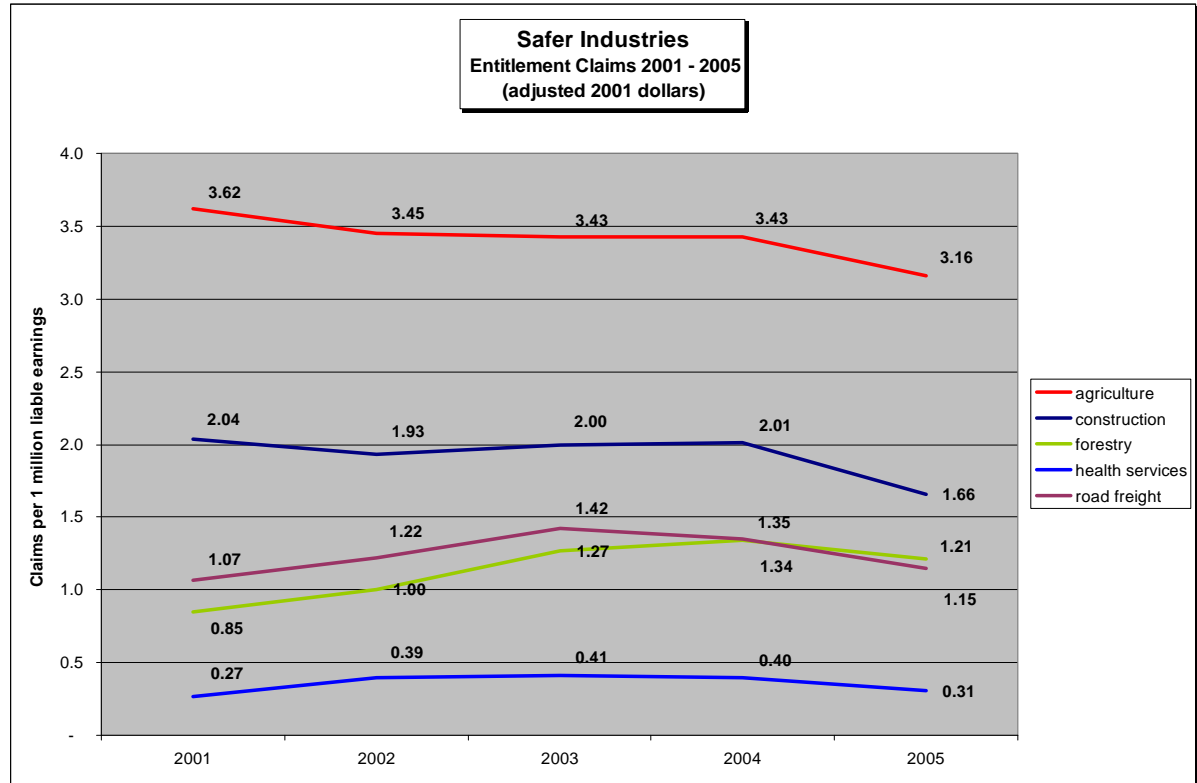
Agriculture reduced by

- **Effective monitoring**

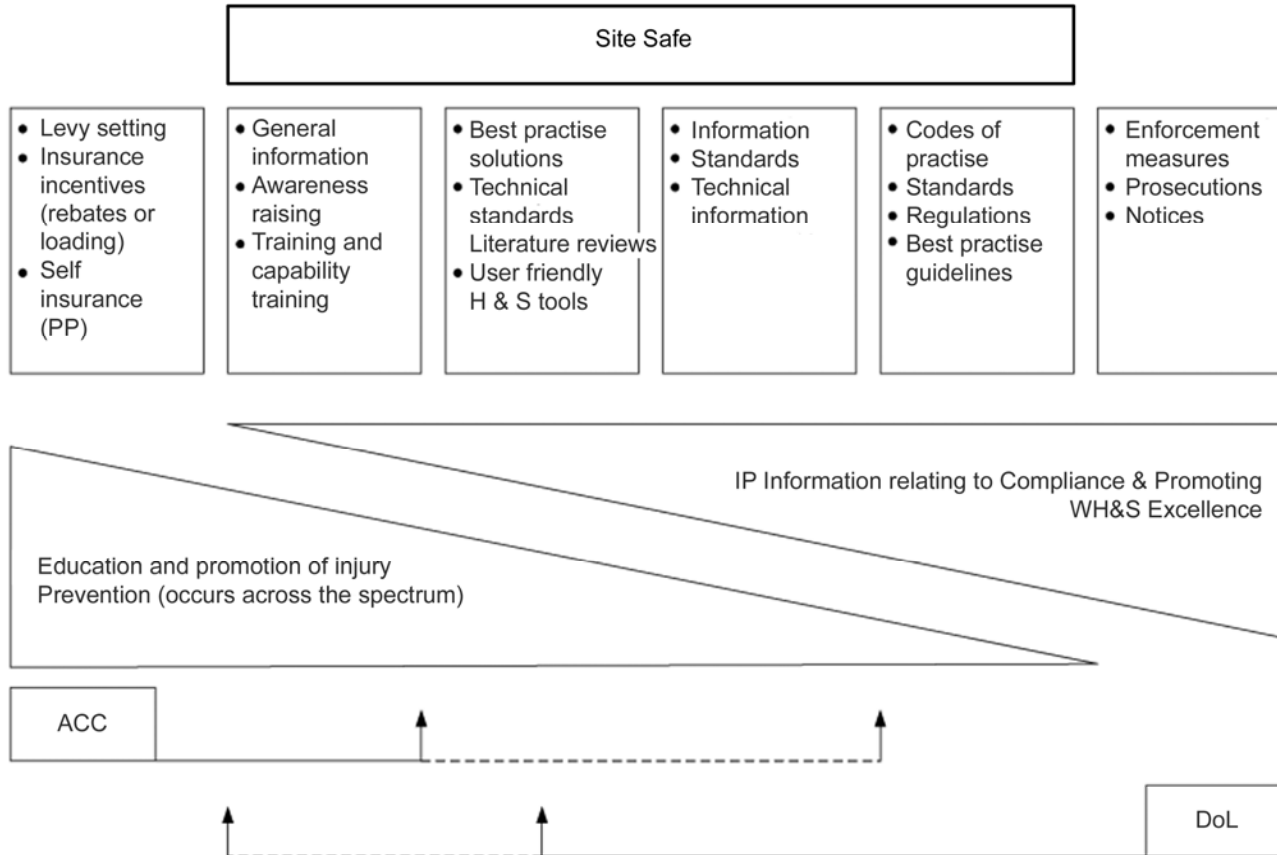

# Matrix of Injury Prevention



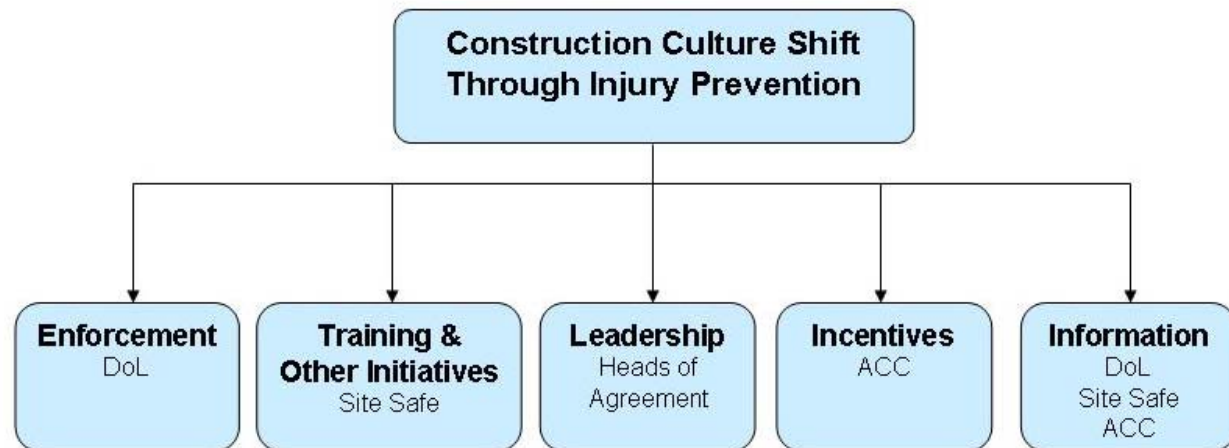
## Matrix of Workplace Injury Prevention Intervention

- **Partnership with Government – Agreement with ACC and DOL**

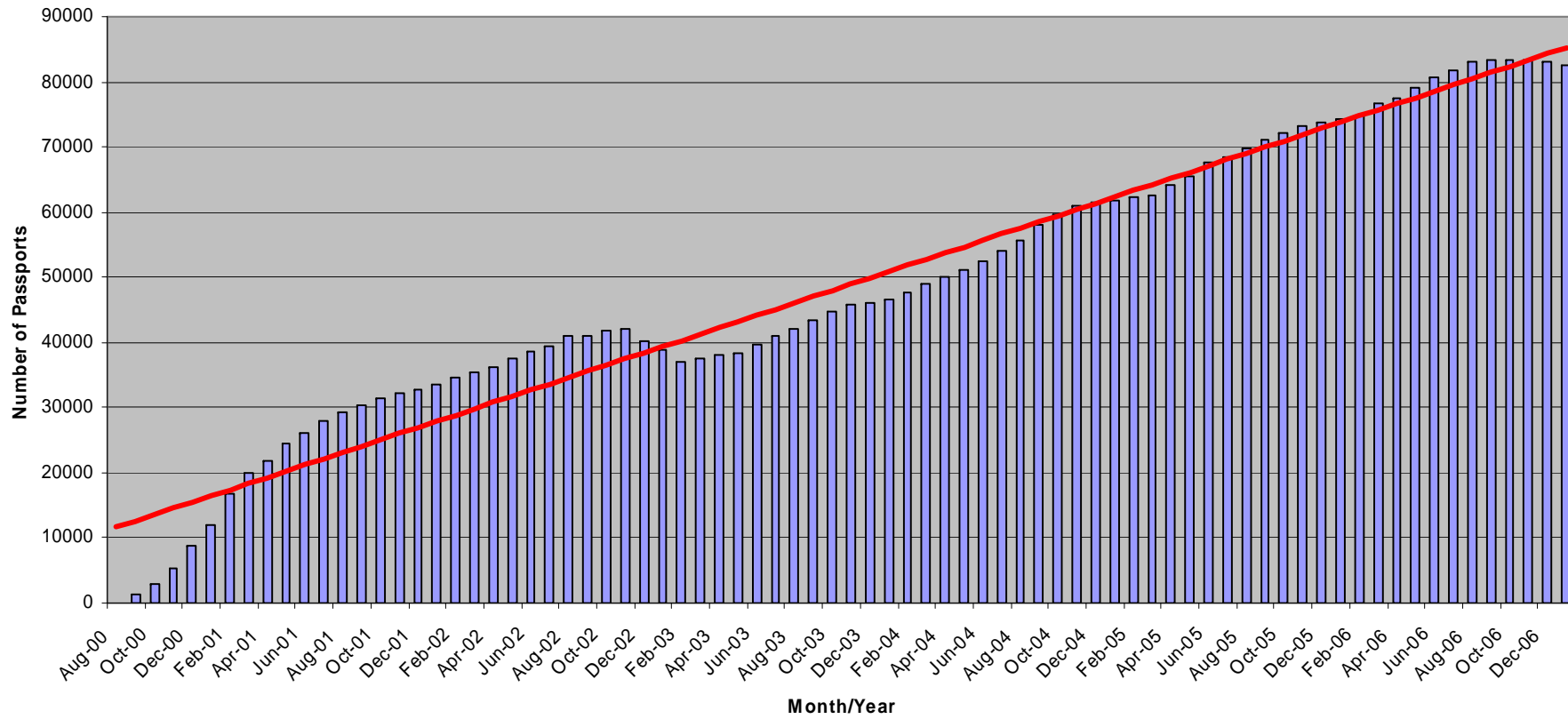




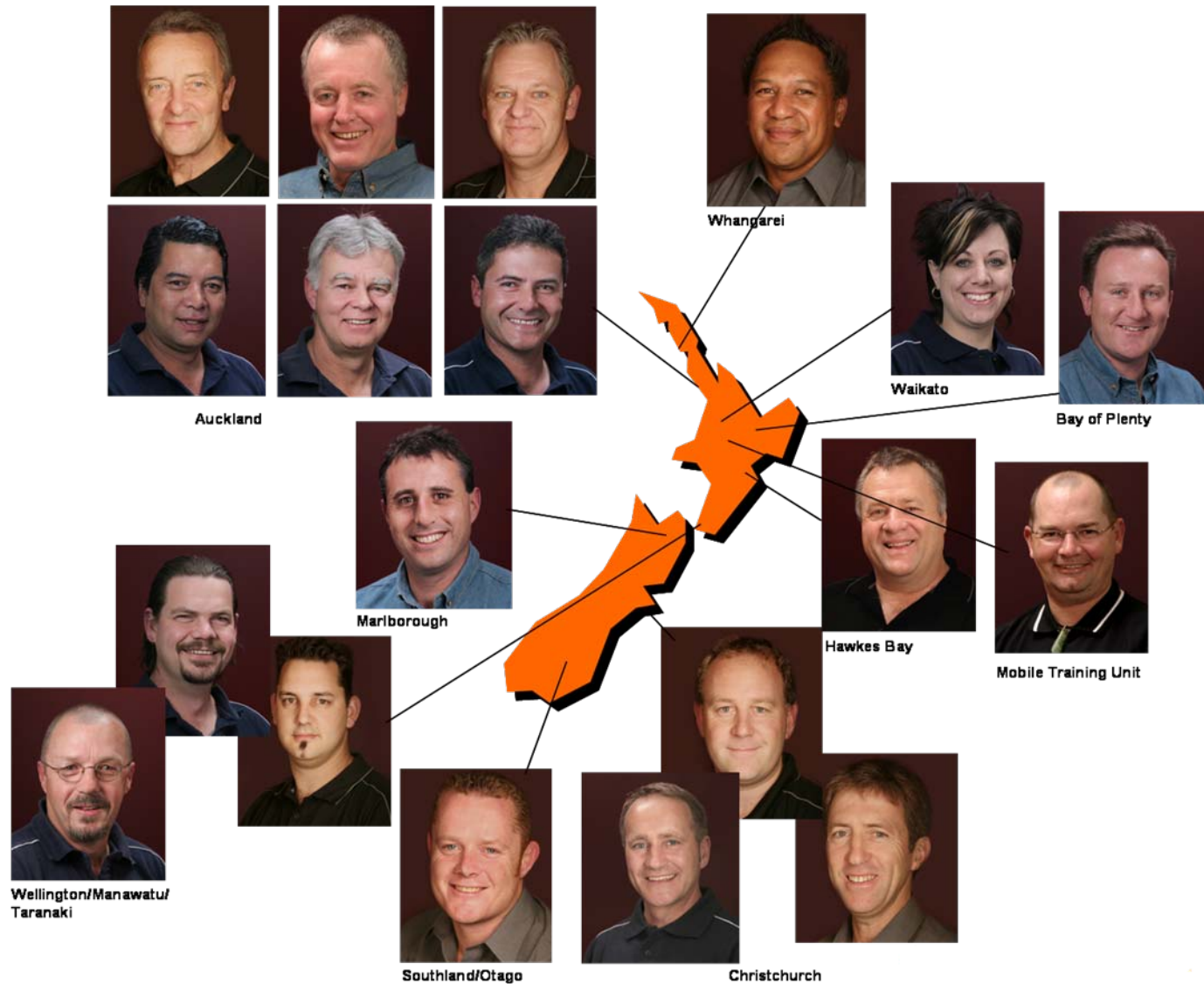
