

    - Movement for Innovation set up





Reportable accidents per 100k employed (Industry AIR)




#### **Demonstrations**

# **Demonstration Performance 2006 compared to Industry Performance 2006**










Predictability of Partnered or Negotiated Contracts v. All Other Contractor Selection Methods 1998 to 2002 Data


