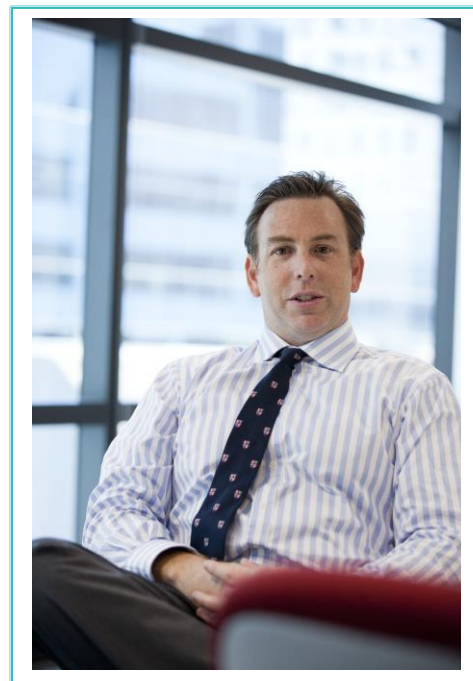
Professor Andrew Harris
