Duties of a Principal

- Legal Viewpoint Simon Penlington
 - Not sufficient to rely on just engaging a competent contractor
 - Principals must ensure contractors have measures in place to manage hazards on the site
 - Principals must ensure the measures are working and that the work is carried out safely

"What gets measured gets done"




Duties of a Principal

- Take "All Practicable Steps" to ensure no Employee of a Contractor is harmed
- As Principals/Clients your main objective is to ensure Contractors are self-managing safety
 - Contractors are responsible for their own site safety planning
- Principals are responsible for
 - Communicating what you want
 - Monitoring that safety activities are happening
 - · Recognising Contractors who are doing it
 - Coaching Contractors who are not






