The Northern Corridor Improvements (NCI) project will build a new direct motorway-tomotorway connection on the North Shore, providing a new and efficient direct route for commuters and freight travelling between Auckland Airport, West Auckland, Manukau and Hamilton. The new link will connect SH1 directly with a redesigned Upper Harbour Highway (SH18), opening up access to the new Western Ring Route.

Creating a new direct motorway-to-motorway connection will allow travellers to avoid travelling through the central city and keep local roads free for local traffic by separating motorway and local traffic.

Gavin Hendricks has been part of the project since day 1 and brings us an overview of the project, how a Hybrid Alliance can be successful and the challenges COVID-19 has brought.
