Procurement Maturity - Survey Feedback

Almost half of respondents are not strategic or forward-looking in their procurement actions

Many don't think beyond the next 12 months

Talent is a challenge with most organisations struggling

Most have non-existent or weak supply chain relationships

Organisations are inconsistent with supply chain engagement processes
