9.15am Bernie Cuttance, Principal Advisor, Land Transport New Zealand will lead this session that will provide insight into the huge consultation process that may result in potential changes to the government transportation procurement procedures.

The current competitive pricing procedures (CPPs) were introduced in the early 1990s, with the aim of increasing efficiency, promoting innovation and creating private sector markets. Under the Land Transport Management Act 2003 (LTMA), CPPs are now called *procurement procedures*, and Land Transport NZ has replaced Transfund as the approving agency. Under the LTMA, Land Transport NZ's objective is 'to allocate resources and to undertake its functions in a way that contributes to an integrated, safe, responsive and sustainable land transport system'.

Land Transport NZ's procurement policies, and the procurement procedures it approves, must be consistent with the above objective hence a review of the procurement procedures was instigated.
